

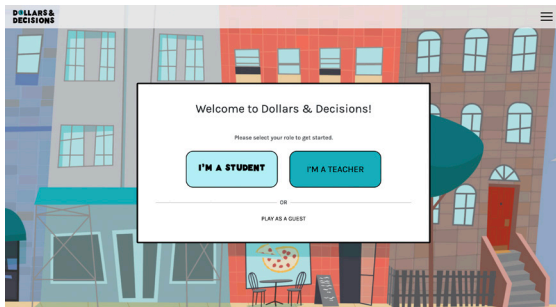
# DOLLARS & DECISIONS

## Teacher Dashboard User Guide

Whether you've played Dollars & Decisions with your class or are brand-new to our interactive financial literacy course for teens, you're going to want our latest update to track your students' progress: the Teacher Dashboard! In this guide, we'll show you exactly how to use it. Check it out!

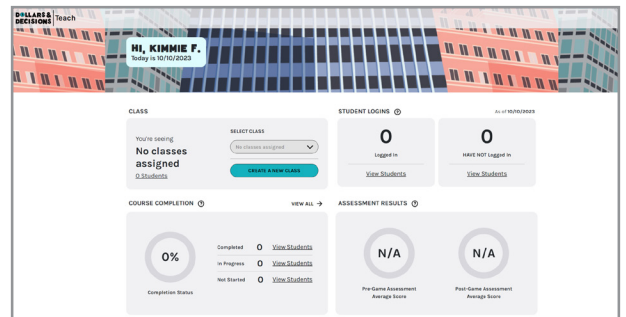
### Setting Up My Teacher Dashboard

1. Go to [dollarsdecisions.com](https://dollarsdecisions.com). If you've played before, it will look a little different.
2. Click on the **"I'm a Teacher"** button.



3. Click on the **"Sign Up"** link at the very bottom.
4. **Create your account.** You can also sign up with Google.
5. This will log you in to your dashboard for the first time.

6. Click on the **"Create a New Class"** button.



7. Enter a Class Name (e.g., Period 1) and enter all student names using the **"Add New Student"** button.
8. Click the **"Create Class"** button.
9. You will see a class code. Write it down or copy it (but don't worry: you'll be able to find it later).
10. Click the **"Back to Dashboard"** button.
11. Repeat steps 6 through 10 for as many classes as you have.

## Logging Students In

1. Go to [dollarsdecisions.com](https://dollarsdecisions.com).
2. Have them click on the “I’m a Student” button.
3. Have them click on the “Sign Up” link at the very bottom.
4. Provide students with the class code.
5. Invite them to create an account by selecting their name from the drop-down menu and creating a password. Usernames are auto-generated.
6. This will log them in and they can start the game. If they don’t finish, the next time they log in, they’ll come back to wherever they left off.

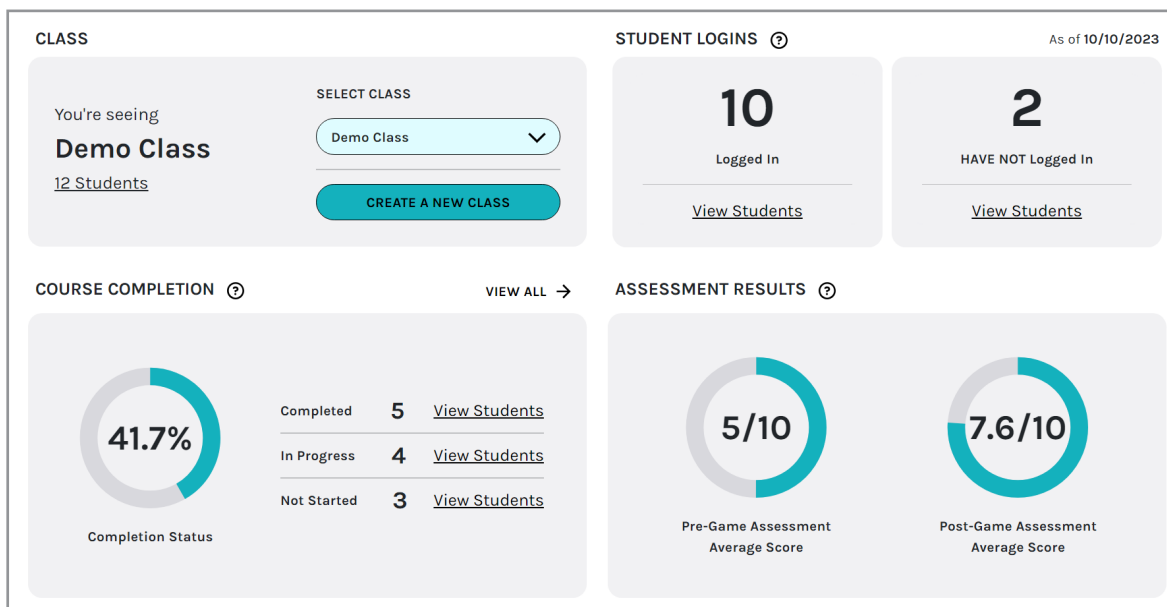

## Seeing My Class Results

Once your students have played the game, you can log in to your Teacher Dashboard to see their progress, including:

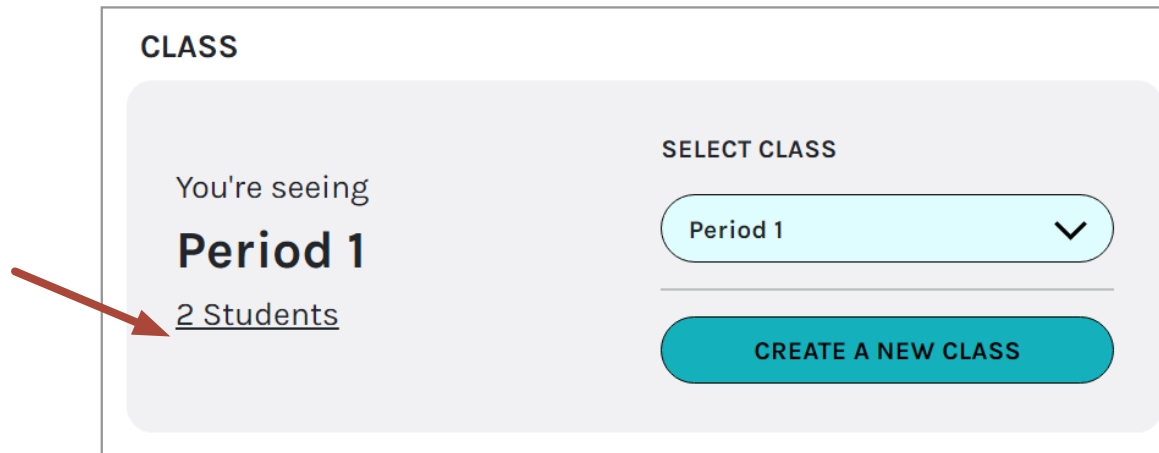
- How many and which students have created accounts.
- How many and which students have completed the course.
- How students performed on their pre- and post-assessments on average. (Click on “Assessment Results” to see detailed results on individual students.)

If you have more than one class, simply change your selection in the drop-down menu to see each class’s results.



## Making Class Changes

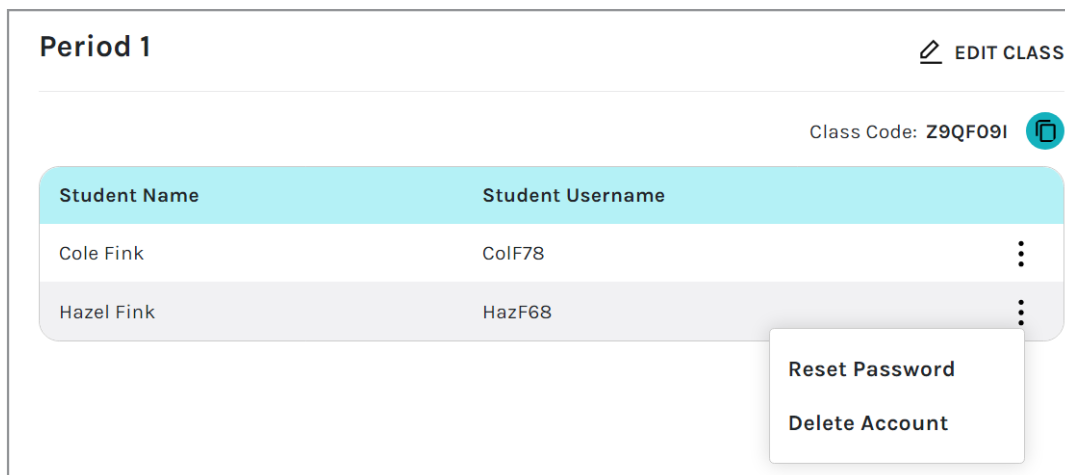
To edit your class list, see the class code, or access students' usernames, select the correct class from the drop-down menu and click on **"X Number of Students."**



To add or delete students, click on **"Edit Class."**

### To reset a student's password:

- Follow the above directions to edit the class.
- Click on the three dots next to the student's name.
- Click **"Reset Password."**



- You can choose to get an auto-generated password or create a custom one.
- You'll get an option to copy the password to the clipboard or print it.
